COMMUNITY GROUP DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

ICEBREAKER: What's one country you would love to visit? Is there anything about the culture of that country that you really like or are intrigued by?

- 1. Peter's prejudice kept him from believing Gentiles could be saved until God intervened. What personal or cultural barriers stop you from sharing the gospel with other people? How can the Spirit help you overcome them?
- 2. Cornelius was "good" but needed the Gospel of Jesus. Who in your life seems "good" but may not know Christ? How can you pray for or share the gospel with them?
- 3. The sermon urges us to see "everyone, everywhere" as candidates for the gospel. Who in your daily life (e.g., coworker, neighbor) could you share Jesus with this week, and how would you initiate that conversation [Wouldn't it be nice if God gave them a vision]?
- 4. God wants to reach all 7 billion people, including unreached groups in places like Bhutan. How can we keep the world in mind when it comes to reaching everyone with the Gospel?
