## **COMMUNITY GROUP DISCUSSION QUESTIONS**

**ICEBREAKER:** What's the most dangerous or high-risk situation you've ever been in—whether it was a serious one or just something that felt scary at the time?

- 1. Stephen was faithful in daily service before he was faithful in death (Acts 6:8). In what small, everyday ways can we serve faithfully right now so that we are prepared to stand firm in bigger trials later?
- 2. Stephen's bold sermon flowed from knowing the Word of God deeply (Acts 7:2-53). How can we saturate ourselves in Scripture so that it naturally shapes what we say and do when pressure comes?
- 3. Stephen didn't just die for Jesus—he died like Jesus, forgiving his killers (Acts 7:54-60). What practical steps help us develop Christ-like courage before we need it?
- 4. The main point was: The Spirit of God prepares the people of God to die for the sake of God. What might it cost you personally to live for Jesus right now?
